

**Family-Teacher Conference Day**

**Get Involved!**

Throughout the school year families have many opportunities to support their child's success in school. Family-Teacher Conference Days are an important way to stay connected and engaged.

**What is Family-Teacher Conference Day?**

JCPS sets aside one day each semester for families to come to school and meet with their child's teachers. This is known as Family-Teacher Conference Day.

This semester, that day is: **February 17, 2026**

**Why Attend a Family-Teacher Conference Day?**

Findings consistently demonstrate that children experience greater success in school when families are actively involved in their education. Family-Teacher Conference Days provide an opportunity to gain a clear understanding of what your child is learning, discuss academic progress and classroom participation, review strengths and areas for growth, and learn practical strategies to support your child's learning at home.

**What Should Families Know?**

- Each school may have a different process for Family-Teacher Conference Day.
- Some schools may ask families to complete a confirmation form ahead of time.
- If you have not received conference details at least three workdays in advance, contact the school by phone, in person, or with a note in your home language.
- If you need an interpreter, let the school know several days in advance.
- Conferences usually last 10-15 minutes, so it helps to come prepared.

\*Families may request additional conferences at any time during the school year.

**Tips for a Successful Conference:**

- Arrive on time. If your arrival falls, the teacher may be meeting with another family.
- Prepare questions ahead of time. Consider asking:
  - How does my child behave in class?
  - Does my child interact with peers?
  - Does my child participate?
  - Is my child completing classwork successfully?
  - How can my child improve?
  - How can I support my child at home?

\* Some teachers may wait for families to share concerns, so please feel comfortable asking questions if your child receives Exceptional Child Education (ECE) or English Language Development (ELD).




Save the date for Aflora 2026 on September 19th.


